<p><i>Background: Salinas Valley Recycles is beginning an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) based on the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the Long-Term Facility Needs Project. The Project will study a new location for a permanent transfer station for waste disposal, recycling and resource recovery center. The Project would allow SVR to implement State law requirements to increase recycling and landfill diversion activities. The Project includes studying a single site or a mix of locations in the County for the facilities/programs. A total of five site locations will be studied for the Project and each site will be evaluated based on a range of impact categories such as noise, traffic, air quality, etc.</i></p>

<p><b>Aesthetics</b> Ex: Visual characteristics and impacts. Light or glare to surrounding public views.</p>	
<p><b>Air Quality/Greenhouse Gas Emissions</b> Ex: Greenhouse gas emission increases and/or reductions from construction and operation (including odors and dust).</p>	
<p><b>Cultural Resources</b> Ex: Historical artifacts and resources found on the project site.</p>	
<p><b>Hazards and Hazardous Materials</b> EX: Hazards and hazardous materials associated with short-term construction and long-term operation activities. Onsite household hazardous waste facility.</p>	
<p><b>Hydrology and Water Quality</b> Ex: Storm water design and water quality. Climate change impacts such as warming temperatures, changes in precipitation, and sea level rise.</p>	
<p><b>Land Use and Planning</b> Ex: Consistency with applicable land use and zoning designations, plans, and policies; compatibility with other land uses. Variances or rezoning at the different sites.</p>	



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<p><b>Noise and Vibration</b> Ex: Short-term construction and long-term operational noise impacts to surrounding land uses, focusing on nearby communities.</p>	
<p><b>Transportation/ Traffic</b> Ex: Increase in traffic from truck and vehicle trips to surrounding roadways and intersections.</p>	
<p><b>Utilities and Public Services</b> Ex: Impacts to water supply, wastewater collection and treatment, solid waste, police and fire services, and schools and associated infrastructures.</p>	
<p><b>Growth Inducing Impacts</b> Ex: Effects or ways the project could foster economic or population growth, or removal of obstacles to growth.</p>	
<p><b>Cumulative Impacts</b> Ex: Cumulative impacts of the project when combined with past, present, and reasonably anticipated future projects in the area.</p>	
<p><b>Legal &amp; Regulatory Compliance</b> Ex: Complying with the environmental and waste reduction laws and regulations of the State.</p>	
<p><b>Waste Reduction, Recycling and Landfilling</b> Ex: Increasing recycling and reducing landfilling of wastes.</p>	
<p><b>Access to Public Services</b> Ex: Disposal, recycling and household hazardous waste services in proximity to users, ease of access.</p>	
<p><b>Costs</b> Ex: Effects on rate payers' garbage &amp; recycling bills. Community benefits vs. cost.</p>	
<p><b>Economic Development</b> Ex: Job creation or reduction, project demand for local services and local tax benefits.</p>
