

## Safe Disposal Mobile Collection Service for Homebound Seniors and Residents with Disabilities (hereinafter “Homebound Service”)

The Homebound Service offers FREE at-home pick up of special waste materials: ABOP (Antifreeze, Batteries, Oil and Paint) to Salinas Valley residents who meet the following criteria:

- Salinas Valley resident;
- Homebound persons aged 65 and older;
- Homebound persons with physical limitations or medical conditions that prevent driving a vehicle.

This pick-up service assists senior citizens and physically challenged residents who are unable to transport special wastes and do not have readily available assistance from others to deliver their waste to a certified HHW collection facility.

Qualifying residents can call (or leave a message with) the **HHW Facility** at **(831) 424-5520**, from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, except holidays, to schedule a FREE pick-up. A collection date will be scheduled between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm. Participants **MUST** complete and sign a liability waiver prior to service.

You will be asked:

- Are you a homebound senior (65 or older)?  Yes  No

Please note:

- The home collection staff does not collect other special wastes such as pesticides/herbicides, insecticides, weed killers and poisons, oil-based paints, acids/bases, solvents, household cleaners, prescription drugs/medications, tires, mattresses or explosives.
- Staff cannot enter dwellings, storage sheds, garages, or fenced backyards unless participant is home and signs a liability waiver.
- Qualifying residents may use the Homebound Service four (4) times per calendar year at no charge.
- **IMPORTANT:** A maximum of 15 gallons or 125 pounds will be collected per appointment.

#### STEPS FOR HOME COLLECTION HHW PICKUP:

1. Contact HHW facility to schedule a pick-up and explain the type of waste you wish to have picked up from your home or complex.
2. Complete and sign liability waiver.
3. You will receive a confirmation from the home collection staff with the anticipated pickup date. The morning of your collection appointment, a home collection staff will call to confirm their arrival time.
4. If left outside, special waste materials must be packed securely in sturdy upright boxes and placed where it can be seen and easily accessed from the street.
