A study done by the Natural Resources Defense Council in 2016 estimated that, "six million turkeys - a value of roughly \$293 million - ended up in the trash". Previously, approximately **9.1%** of plastic was recycled, now it is estimated that only **4.4%** will be recycled this year. If nothing changes, this will drop down to **2.9%** next year. Even though people should still recycle, it is more
