#### 3. Update on the Expansion of the Organics Program (SB 1383 and Composting Facility)

(4:16) Resource Recovery Manager Brooks presented an update on the Senate Bill (SB) 1383 organics recovery programs and the operation of the new composting facility that will help meet the Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority

State mandates. She reviewed in detail the definition of organic waste as defined by the mandates and the reason behind the focus of diversion of organic waste. Mrs. Brooks explained the contracts that have been awarded and the equipment purchased to continue making progress on the program expansion. Mrs. Brooks reported that as of June 8th, Vision Recycling, the Authority's organics processor, began creating compost on the new state of the art Aerated Static Pile compost pad. She detailed the use of the recently purchased mixer and tractor to combine the de-packager wet slurry and ground green waste for composting on the new pad. She indicated the Board approved in May the purchase of a second food recovery truck for the Food Bank to assist in the recovery of edible food. The truck is scheduled to arrive in a few weeks, and it will be wrapped with graphics promoting food rescue and recovery efforts.

### 4. Update on the Sun Street Transfer Station Relocation Project

(4:51) General Manager/CAO Mathews reported this projected would be one of the main focuses of the Advisory Committee. He provided a brief history of how the potential project came about, the preliminary actions needed, the estimated timeline, the stakeholders identified and their responsibility, as well as the development of the proposed facility plan. He indicated discussions have taken place with the Republic Services to discuss the acquisition of one of three parcels at the Madison Lane Transfer Station with a meeting scheduled for July 10. Meetings between Republic Services and Authority, as well as, between the County of Monterey and the Authority have been scheduled to discuss the proposed schedule of the project, the structure developed, and the project support need by each. Mr. Mathews indicated that if the project moves forward this would allow the Authority to continue providing services to the City of Salinas' residents in the most cost-effective manner.
