How the De-Packager Works?

Businesses separate all organic packaged materials in a different container from trash and recycling.

Do not mixed trash or other non-organic materials with packaged materials.

The de-packager separates all organic materials from its packaging. The de-packaged organic

materials are then turned in to energy and/or compost.

Acceptable Materials



- ✓ **Bagged Produce** (Fruit or Vegetable)
- ✓ **Produce in Clamshells** (Fruit or Vegetable)
- ✓ Master packs (dressings, toppings, etc.)
- ✓ Packaged Food Products (i.e. expired grocery store waste)



Unacceptable Materials

No 🚫

- **○** Plastic Strapping
- Plastic Rolls
- **○** Trash
- Cardboard rolls
- Gloves, hair nets, aprons, rubber band, etc.



Organic materials sent to compost have reduced fees (vs. garbage). *Reduced fees apply only to clean loads of organic packaged materials*

Contaminated loads are subject to garbage rates.
