2013 Elected Officers

Revised Meetings Calendar for 2013 – New meeting time for Executive Committee meetings

The new meeting time for the Executive Committee was changed to 4:00 p.m. The next Strategic Planning Retreat was changed to Friday July 19, 2013.

2013 Strategic Plan Goals and Six-month Objectives

Revisions to the Objectives of the Strategic Plan Goals were approved as recommended by the Board at the January 18, 2013, retreat. The goals remain as follows:

- A. Develop and Implement a Sustainable Finance Plan
- B. Promote Authority's Role and Value as a Resource Recovery Agency
- C. Achieve 75% Diversion by 2015
- D. Enhance Existing Facilities, Equipment and Public Services
- E. Promote and Maintain a High Performance, Efficient and Flexible Workforce

Crazy Horse Landfill Closure Project

The Board authorized further work by San Benito Supply for the Crazy Horse Landfill Closure Project. This brings the project very close to completion. Staff estimates that the project will be completed by mid-February.

Outreach Policy To Residents of the Authority

This item was continued to February. This policy would adopt additional bilingual outreach measures beyond minimum State and Federal standards to further encourage community participation. It includes translation of Board and Executive Committee agendas and Board Meeting Highlights, as well as the looking into the formation of a citizen's advisory committee.

Fiscal Year 2013-14 Budget Preview

Staff presented a budget calendar plan to help the budget development process be more productive. In February, the Board will focus on the financial items that will set the path to the approval of the 2013-14 Budget. Staff is recommending that the agency stop using South Valley revenues to cover general operations effective July 1, 2013. That would result in a rate increase. The Board will be targeting to hold a public hearing in March. The topics to discuss in February are:

- Financial policies
- Five year capital improvement plan
- Five year forecast

- 2013-14 preliminary operating budget
- 2013-14 capital improvement budget
- Rate setting

 - RRI for WM effective 1/01/13 is 2.8%
- Major issues

 - Financing future capital improvements
