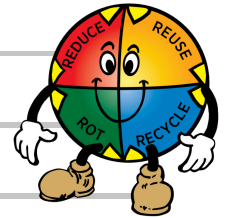


## School Food Waste Program

One of our most popular programs is our school composting presentation. Students get to learn about different types of composting and they get to meet our live decomposers. This hands on experience exposes students to the positive attributes of our common garden critters and the reasons why composting is important for our planet.

## Facility Field Trips \* NEW EDUCATION CENTER

Make the connection between the trash can and the landfill. Students get to see where their trash goes after it leaves the curb. Tour one of our three open facilities; Jolon Transfer Station, Madison Lane Recycling Center or the Johnson Canyon Landfill. The landfill also provides opportunity to see the de-packager machine, composting facility, our methane gas to electricity facility and our big equipment in action!



## FIND OUT HOW YOU CAN EARN A FREE FIELD TRIP TO THE EDUCATION CENTER! BUS FEES INCLUDED!

To organize the upcoming sustainability field trip, start by recruiting enough classes to fill the bus and obtain a bus quote from the transportation department. Participate in a landfill presentation before the trip and host two sustainable activities at your school with SVR staff support. Schedule a wrap-up presentation to reflect on the trip and discuss future initiatives. Finally, prepare for the trip, which will last approximately four hours on-site, ensuring a valuable learning experience for the students.

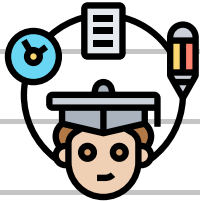
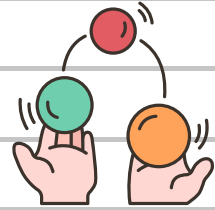
On our websites Kid's Corner, we offer links to fun and educational online games, songs, videos and books! This site is family and classroom friendly.
